Researchers have only recently begun to study the complex phenomenon of dispatch priming. There isn't a universally accepted definition. Dispatch priming includes how dispatchers present information to an officer and how that influences how the officer thinks about and responds to a call for service. Said differently, the delivery, tone, and experience of a dispatcher can influence first responder behavior.

This course provides call takers and dispatchers with tools to avoid complacency and bias and thereby help officers in the field make good decisions. Join us for an in-depth look into dispatch priming and the complex cognitive processes affecting dispatchers and call takers.
